- GPA Update- everything going smooth. Educating our parents about wearing masks. Teaching students how to keep themselves and others clean.
- EA Update - Donation of water bottles from Mushroom Plant. Masks are going well. Provide extra masks when needed. Campus could use extra backpacks, extra school supplies, shoes, and socks.
- GE Update - All is good. Had to adjust drop off times due to additional grade levels. Masks are going well. They are taking masks breaks as much as possible. Chromebooks have been beneficial. CPS calls have increased, unfortunately. We have noticed somewhat a regression of our special populations. They have adjusted the schedules.
- NA Update - relatively good. Working well with the assistant-principal has a handle on things. Additional staff members are always needed.
- GJH Update - running pretty smooth. Only a handful of students not back yet. Having to remind students to keep masks over their noses. Students are wanting to talk more due to the students being cooped up at home. Teachers feel better without having to do both onsite and remote learning. Transition block scheduling (4 lunches), limited rotations, breaks in the classrooms, etc.
- GHS Update - good very well, highly numbers of strep, replacing dirty masks. Reminding students to place the masks above their noses. Trying to keep students six feet away from each other. Doing their best. Staff is working hard with monitoring things. Tardies are limited and have decreased. Just started off-campus lunches.

OnRamps has begun this year. This is a great opportunity for our students to earn college credits and college credit.

- Nurse Update - waiting for hearing machines to be calibrated. Waiting on finance. Check with FO.
- Counselor Update- meeting and virtual trainings.
- Operations (safety, security, transportation, custodial) Update - cleaning protocols are working. We purchased thermal thermometers for JH and HS. We have purchased bottle refilling stations. We have adjusted our transportation as well to ensure we keep our students safe. Elementary and secondary are separated as much as possible.
- Food Service Update- ALL meals are free this year. FS is doing a great job accommodating the schools and which classes are eating in the classrooms or in the cafe. The numbers are good overall. Started posting the lunch newsletters. Food protocols are implemented. Packaged foods and things are going very well. Getting ready for a state review in the upcoming week.
- Others:
  - Felipe Leon - commended our staff on a job well done. Does take protocols in place as well as us. Commends us for all the protocols that we have had to put in place. Everyone has done a good job. Early morning drop off has been smooth. Open up more lines for parents in and out have been working and is smooth. Tradition makes sense to him. Everything is well organized. Maintaining distancing.
